Flag bearers are also needed—interested players can email info@elorarocks.com.

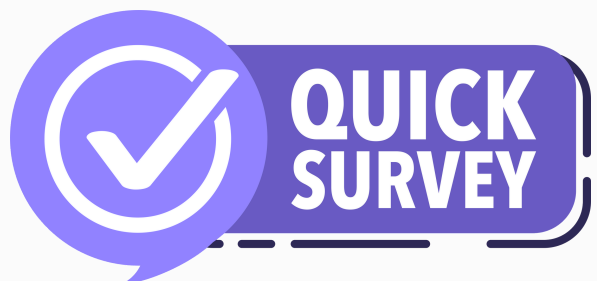

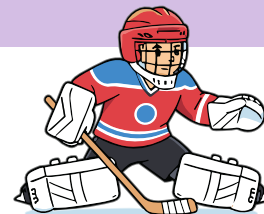

Playoffs
