

Grand River Mustang Import Policy

Imports will be considered for Mustang rep level teams, however, it is the desire and commitment of the GRMGH to develop the girls registered within the association and to provide them with the opportunity to play and grow within the organization.

First Teams

A GRMGHI player shall not be considered an import, in any of the following instances:

- a) They do not require a Permission to Skate (PTS) form in order to tryout
- b) Parent(s)/guardian(s) pay residential property taxes to the Township of Centre Wellington
- c) They played for a Mustang team in the preceding season

All the above is subject to approval from the Mustang Board or designated committee .

Maximum numbers of imports for the first team as follows:

- Novice – 0 imports
- Atom – 2 imports
- Peewee – 3 imports
- Bantam – 3 imports
- Midget – 3 imports

Goalies: An import goalie will be considered an import if the number of goalies from the season prior who are trying out equals or exceeds the number of goalies required in that division. eg. In a division where 4 goalie spots are available, if only 3 Mustangs goalies try out, the fourth goalie could be an import (as described above) without counting toward the team total allowable imports. However, if there are enough available Mustangs goalies trying out, any import goalie offered a spot on a team will be included on the team's overall import list.

All rosters require approval from the Mustang Board or designated Committee.

Any requests for exceptions to the Import Policy are subject to the approval of the Mustang Board of or designated committee.

Second Teams:

On second teams preference will be given to non-import girls who are capable of playing at the designated level. Any requests for imports must be approved by the Mustang Board or designated committee. If imports are allowed they will not exceed the number allowed under first team policy, unless deemed necessary by the Mustang Board or designated committee.
